The truck will have a five year, 60,000 mile warranty and full service contract. The City has the money in the contingency fund to pay for the truck. Mayor Goff feels that this truck will be a benefit to the City and the cost is a good deal. Councilwoman Cooper says that using the truck as a snowplow will be very helpful on our narrow streets.
