**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

Mayor Goff called the meeting to order with Councilpersons Cooper, White, Corvinus, and Riley present. Also present City Clerk, Gina Elmer.

Pledge of Allegiance

Councilwoman Cooper made a **motion** to approve the agenda. Councilman White **seconded**. All ayes. **Motion carried**.

New Business:

Mike Martin: Mike is here to present the Council with a change order for \$9,400.00 on the new production well. As the well was being drilled there was cause to bore a bigger hole due to all the big river rock they encountered. This required more filter packing and it will take more man hours to complete. They are getting about 100GPM right now but once it is completed hopefully it will reach upwards of 200GPM. Mike also had an example of why it is important to have a secondary source of water. There was a train that derailed and landed in the Kootenai River in Boundary County and caused water quality issues for the City of Bonners Ferry. Councilman White does not understand why they did not compensate for the type of materials they were drilling in on the original bid. Councilman Riley also questioned the amount of time allotted on the original bid. There was much discussion about holding bids to their original amounts instead of having change orders all the time. Councilman White made a motion to allow the change order not to exceed \$9,400.00. Councilman Corvinus seconded. All ayes. Motion carried.
