She should hear about the EMS grant by the end of the week. Cheryl would also like to meet with the Mayor to decide on the grants she should apply for.

• City Engineer:

Amy Woodruff said that they are finalizing the plans for the well and intake structure. They have been working with the City to gather information on the Tamarack Property to determine capacity of the water system and fire flow.
